



## Greenvale School – Learning Support Assistant Advert

Learning Support Assistants are required to join the team at this outstanding school. The successful candidates will work within a class under the direction of the teacher and alongside other support staff to assist in the education and care of students at Greenvale.

Greenvale is Lewisham's community special school for children and young people aged 11–19 who have significant learning difficulties, including those with an additional diagnosis of autism and those with additional medical needs. Many pupils have physical and sensory disabilities, and some of our young people have profound and multiple learning difficulties.

We cater for young people with a wide range of learning needs through our pathways approach, which ensures their learning and provision is tailored appropriately. Some students join us from specialist settings, while others transition from mainstream primary schools.

The school operates across two purpose-built sites with state-of-the-art learning facilities:

- **Waters Road, North Downham** – Key Stages 3 and 4
- **Mayow Road, Forest Hill** – Key Stage 5 and Glade Pathway students

*Applicants should be willing and prepared to work on either site.*

**Hours:** 32.5 hours per week, Monday to Friday, term time only (39 weeks)

**Pay rate:** LBL Grade Scale 3, points 5–6: £31,086.00 – £31,530.00 (FTE equivalent).

**Approximate actual starting salary:** £24,424 (pay award pending April 2026)
