Meals Supervisor Job Description

Greenvale School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment.

The successful applicant will be requested to have a DBS check.

Hours of work – 11.45 a.m., in the class to 2:00 p.m daily, during term time.

Meals supervisors are attached to a class group and are therefore a member of the class's staff team. Lunchtime is a part of the educational day and an appropriate learning environment needs to be maintained throughout. Meal supervisors have a participatory role as well as a supervisory role during the lunchtime period. Meals supervisors work under the direction of the class teacher and the Headteacher.

The work with students includes:

- 1. Implementing Feeding Programmes
 These programmes will vary according to the individual needs
 of the students and will include helping to develop good feeding
 patterns, developing independence and appropriate socially
 acceptable behaviour.
- 2. Implementing Toileting Programmes
 These will include changing, assisting when required,
 supervision of students and good general hygiene practices.
- 3. Supervision and preparation of Meals Tables
 The class staff will advise on student's self-help programmes.
- 4. Working and Playing with Students
 The students have a break split between the playground and
 the classroom. The teacher will advise on appropriate activities
 and role for the meals supervisor. Positive and constructive
 activities should be encouraged with good behaviour at all
 times.
- 5. General Duties as required by the Class Teacher These to be directed. It is the responsibility of the meals supervisor to report any areas of concern to the class teacher whether it is in relation to feeding, behaviour or health matters.

There are 5 staff development days during the year, during which time some relevant training is given.
