General Notes for Meals Supervisor

Greenvale School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment.

The successful applicant will be requested to have a DBS check.

Greenvale School is a secondary school for students with severe learning difficulties (SLD). In addition, many students have profound and multiple learning difficulties (PMLD) and are dependent on others for their personal needs. Many also have autistic spectrum disorder (ASD) in addition to their learning difficulty.

At present the school is organised into 13 classes. Each class has a teacher and two or three additional staff depending on the needs of the class. They also have one or two meals supervisors to assist at lunchtime.

Meals supervisors work in a class team for a year and can expect to gain experience throughout the school over a number of years.

A full range of staff development is available to all staff including participation in 5 staff development days during the year.

When completing the application form candidates must write about their experience and explain how they meet each of the selection criteria and complete the equal opportunities statement.
