Classes have been taking part in a bake off—Here is the entry for Rowan class





Our vision is for all our students to have the reading skills necessary to reach their full potential. We aim to ensure a balanced mix of approaches, to standardise reading strategies and school routines and to increase staff training. Michaela Wood and Lina Avila will be leading the reading project. Our INSET day on 4th of May had a focus on teaching reading to all.



Reading at Greenvale School:

Through our differentiated Pathways all students have opportunities to enjoy reading at their own level. For some this will be through Specialist software, the reading scheme, sensory stories, Makaton signs, cued articulation, communicate in print stories and for others it will be through developing knowledge of phonics. The reading scheme includes a wider range of fiction and non-fiction texts with a higher interest level but at the required reading level for the needs of our students.

Free School Meals
